

## CHART OF FEES AND DUES FOR APPLICANTS

Due to the changes in both national application fees and national dues, the following memo has been prepared to explain the fees and dues that must be included with any application for membership. These changes are explained in greater detail on the National website and are effective for any application submitted after 1 November 2009.

Regular Membership	\$80.00	\$30.00
Junior Membership: 0 – 18 yrs (New Lineage)	\$80.00	\$10.00
Junior Membership: 0 – 18 yrs (Using Established SAR/DAR Lineage)	\$30.00	\$10.00
Junior Membership: 0-18 yrs (CAR Transfer)	\$30.00	\$10.00
Male Relative of SAR Member - Age 18 – 25	\$30.00	\$30.00
CAR Transfer: Age 18 – 22	\$0.00	\$30.00
CAR Transfer: Over age 22	\$80.00	\$30.00
Family Plan: Male Relatives over age 18 applying at the same time <i>(first applicant pays for regular membership – each additional applicant pays the following)</i>	\$30.00	\$30.00

South Carolina Application Fee	\$20.00
South Carolina Dues	\$20.00
2014 Congress Dues Surcharge	<u>\$5.00</u>
<b>Application Payment Subtotal</b>	<b>\$155.00</b>
Chapter Dues	varies
<b>Application Payment Total</b>	<b>\$155.00 + Chapter Dues</b>
